## Breakout Tracks

We are seeking presentations related to innovations in addressing pain and addiction in the following tracks:

### 1. New Care Delivery & Payment Models

This track focuses on evidence-based care delivery interventions to improve access to care, address acute needs of patients, and advance evidence-based pain management practices. Example topics include: new workforce models, clinical processes, new payment models, and toolkits for improving or optimizing the clinical care setting for addressing addiction-related needs and/or transforming pain management practices.

### 2. Emerging Science, Data, and Trainings

This track focuses on the latest information about the addiction and pain management issue and evidence-based best practices to address it. Example topics include: emerging research, data tools, and training resources to better equip and encourage collaboration between diverse stakeholder groups, including those on the frontlines as well as influencers such as health systems leaders and elected officials.

### 3. Policy & Partnerships

This track focuses on innovative, evidence-based policy efforts and partnership models that can be replicated in different community settings or scaled for statewide impact. Abstracts that expand upon theory of change, processes, lessons learned, and impact achieved are highly encouraged.

### 4. Health Equity & Community

This track focuses on understanding and addressing addiction disparities. Example topics include: social determinants of health, leveraging community partnerships, and closing gaps amongst underserved populations.

## Session Types

Within this application, you will be asked which of two formats would be the best fit for your submission:

#### 1) Breakout Session:

A breakout session is a shared 75-minute breakout presentation block. You will be submitting for 30 minutes presentation time and 10 minutes of Q&A that will be shared with another session that the committee determines is a suitable fit. No one submission will be presenting in the full 75 minute block. Breakout sessions take place on both June 18 and June 19.

#### 2) Pre-Summit Workshop:

Pre-summit workshops are in the format of smaller groups for a longer time period with the intention of truly delving down into the "how-tos." This is a three-hour time block that will not be shared with another submission unless otherwise notified.

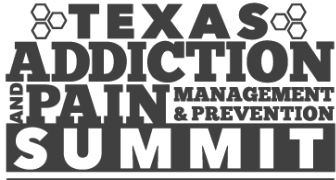
